Course Content

- Identify the risks associated with the use of different types of pedestrian mowers
- Select appropriate Personal Protective Equipment
- Identify and understand the function of all instruments and controls
- Carry out daily checks as indicated in the operators manual
- Carry out pre-start checks
- Identify and report any faults
- Adjust the cutting mechanism to achieve the required standard
- Operate the machine in a safe and competent manner
- Perform after-use maintenance
- Load and transport the machine (if appropriate)

Who should attend?

Anyone required to use a Pedestrian Mower as part of their work. This would include novice and experienced operators who require certification on their skills updating.
