- Pre use safety -
 - Considerations for risk assessments
 - Identify hazards specific to the site, task & machine
 - Economic fuel use
 - Daily maintenance
 - Functions of instructions, controls & safety decals
- Operate the tractor-
 - Carrying out safety checks and perform safe start
 - Braking and stopping procedures
 - Safe stopping procedure
- Hitch trailer and three point linkage implement to tractor
 - Hitching tractor to trailer (incl. hydraulic couplings)
